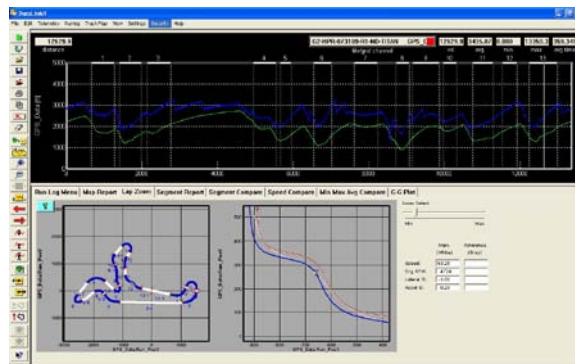


ICAD PROGRAM
